

A List of Where you May Find Supplies

Epoxy Resin: Michaels stores, Curry's Art store, Sculpture Supply Canada (in Toronto but they have a website and will mail supplies to you)

Urethane Resin: Sculpture Supply Canada (in Toronto but they have a website and will mail supplies to you)

Polyester Resin: Michaels (polyester is tricky...not the best for beginners)

Pushable Silicone Molding Material: Curry's Art Store

Pourable Silicone Molding Material: Sculpture Supply Canada (best deal), Curry's Art store (sells "food safe" silicone...much more expensive)

Rings From which To make Molds: Ardenes, Claires, Zellers ... anywhere ...

Polymer Clay: Michaels, Curry's Art

Bezels and Blanks: Etsy has a vast array, Michaels has a very limited amount (buttons and small wood pieces can work too), but has all of the other jewellery findings you will need.

Thin Metal Sheeting for Craft Paper Punches: Stockade Canada in Guelph

Stazon Ink Pads (work on plastic): Michaels

Glitter: I love Martha Stewart Glitter – find it at Walmart or Michaels (take a Michaels coupon and get the large variety pack. I think it is regular 40\$, so take a 40 or 50% off coupon printed from the internet.

Printable Acetate (overhead projector) Sheets: Staples (these are the best ones), Michaels (sells these printable sheets for their Yudu silk screening machine...These ones are covered with some sort of coating and I find sometimes they leave a white film on the sheet)

Pigments and Colorants: Michaels (have the basic transparent red, blue, yellow), Curry's Art Store (has a much bigger selection), Etsy

PearlEx Powders and Pastels: Michaels

Respirator: Canadian Tire has a good **Vapor** one.

Rotary Sander, High number sand paper, polish and small torch: Canada Tire! I have the Mastercraft rotary tool and it has done me well (Started with a less expensive and it broke), Find 600-2000 grit sand papers in the automotive section, get an automotive scratch remover and a plastic polish for the best shine.
