Instructor Application Information

Class Information

GRBS is providing a teaching space at a basic cost to the instructor. The classes will be promoted through the Bead Show and students can sign up ahead of time at the September GRBS meeting, or by contacting the instructor directly, as well as at the Bead Show.

1. Classes will run on both Saturday & Sunday (See schedule of times on application form).
2. The cost to the instructor for teaching at the show is \$10.00 per hour or \$20.00 for a 2.5 hour class. One hour classes are encouraged, however, two hour classes are possible as well as full day classes. The teaching fee will be collected by the GRBS on the day you teach.
3. The instructor will set the minimum and maximum class sizes.
4. Once your class is approved you will be notified and your contact information, class description and photos will be posted on the GRBS website www.GRBSshow.com for students to sign up.
5. The instructor will determine the cost of the class and the kit fee (which should be combined and include HST if applicable).
6. The instructor will provide a sample of the project for the **September** GRBS meeting.
7. Students who sign up for a class will contact the instructor directly via email. They will also be required to pay in advance by whatever method the instructor decides to use.
8. The instructor is encouraged to **promote their class through their own social media and personal email invitations.**
9. If the instructor cancels the class then they need to contact the students.
10. A full day class must incorporate a lunch break.
11. The teaching area will not be supplied with task lights but there are wall plugs that can be accessed.
12. Due to the open area arrangement of the teaching space, consideration needs to be made for classes that involve noise so that the noise does not interfere with the instruction of other classes or vendors at the show. Because of this, no classes that involve hammering will be permitted.
