

Greetings to our Past (and Future) Exhibitors

We're excited to announce details about our 2019 Grand River Bead Society Bead Show:

1. We have a new name and focus: **GRBS Show: Artisan Jewellery, Beads, and Fibre Arts**. We are actively encouraging vendors of finished jewellery and fibre arts to join our current vendors.
2. We are happy to be returning to the **Evergreen Seniors Community Centre** in Guelph.
3. Our show dates will be **October 19-20, 2019**. We were able to keep the mid-October dates.
4. We will be able to maintain our **LOW** table and booth fees! In addition to payment by cheque, you will have the option of **PayPal** payments. If this is your choice, our treasurer will email you a PayPal invoice. In addition, you will also be able to reserve your space with a deposit, instead of full payment.
5. There is **no extra charge for electricity**. However, the number of outlets is limited. See the Guidelines.

Important Details

- **New Vendor Rewards:** First Time Vendors will receive a one-time discount of \$50.
- **Tables:** Our tables are 6' x 30"
- **Half-tables** will be available to small or new artisans. (includes a discount for a new vendor)
- **Show Dates:** Our show days this year are right after Thanksgiving. People are starting to think about Christmas, so artisans selling finished jewellery should have a good opportunity to attract sales.
- **Early Bird Rewards:** Once again, send your applications in early. We will reward early returns with a choice of table/booth location. Your completed application will be dated on arrival! Space allocation will begin September 30th. Later applications will be assigned a location.
- **Layout:** The room is rectangular. A very rough draft of the layout is attached.
- **Marketing** is high on our list of priorities.
 - We will update show website <http://grbsshow.com/> to feature the vendors, classes, and activities.
 - Professionally produced **show cards** are available for vendors.
 - We're planning frequent **newsletters**, bios and information about vendors and their products, and **social media** posts.
 - We have a serious expectation that you, as a vendor, will market the show to your mailing list and on your website and/or Facebook or Instagram page.
- **Classes & Make'nTakes:** We will have time slots available for classes. More information about changes will be coming.
- **In-Show Activities:** We have some new ideas for interesting ideas--stay tuned for announcements.

Location Choices: From now until Sept 1, approved vendor applications will be dated, and vendors will be contacted in that date order to choose their space location.

Terms and Conditions

1. **Acceptance:** Once your completed application and a payment is received and approved you will receive an acceptance email.
2. **Cancellation policy:** Once we receive your application and a payment and it is approved, **there will be no refunds.**
3. **Layout:** Space allocation for individual vendors will begin on September 1, 2019. The receipt of applications with a payment will be dated, and vendors will be contacted in date order for their choice of location. Spaces cannot be combined or split with another vendor.
4. **Show hours:** Set-up is Friday, October 18, 2019, 6:30-9:30 pm and Saturday from 7:00-9:45 am. Move-out on Sunday is from 5:00–8:00 pm.
The show is open for customers from 10:00 am–5:00 pm both Saturday and Sunday.
Exhibitors must be in their booths, ready to welcome customers when the show starts each day, and must remain until 5 pm both days. Packing up before 5:00 pm is **NOT PERMITTED.**
5. **Taxes:** Vendors are responsible for collecting the applicable HST.
6. **Children:** In order to present a professional image to our customers and other vendors, young children are not permitted in your booth during show hours. Show management reserves the right to ask that children be taken outside the showroom.
7. **Insurance:** I acknowledge that I have been advised to arrange for my own vendor insurance for the GRBS Show covering personal injury to myself and my staff as well as property damage including fire and theft as well as liability insurance. I understand that as a condition of participating in the Grand River Bead Show & Sale I release the Grand River Bead Society, the Grand River Bead Society directors, and volunteers from liability or claims for any personal injury, property damage (including fire and theft) or any other damages arising out of or related to participation in the GRBS Show.

I agree to the above Terms and Conditions as a condition of participating in the GRBS Show as a vendor.

Guidelines & Information

1. **Payment:** In addition to payment by cheque, we offer the option of PayPal payments. If this is your choice, our treasurer will email you a PayPal invoice.
2. **Deposits:** This year the completed application may be accompanied by payment in full, or by a deposit. The remainder of the space fees are due July 31, either with a post-dated cheque or by payment of a PayPal Invoice.
3. **Insurance:** It is highly recommended that you arrange for your own insurance to cover any claim for personal injury and property loss or damage. The Grand River Bead Society is not responsible for these losses (see waiver on page 2).
4. **Electricity:** The room is very well lit. If you want decorative lights, consider battery operated LED lights. There are only 7 outlets available along the walls for computers and other necessary equipment. Please bring any extension cords and power bars required.
5. **Tables & chairs:** The tables are 6' x 30". They must be covered with a floor-length cloth. Each vendor will have one chair per table. (There may be extra chairs.)
6. **Badges:** You will be provided with name badges. Please wear them.
7. **Parking:** After you finish unloading, please park away from the loading doors so that customers have access to the closer spaces.
8. **Booth design:** We expect booths to look attractive and professional. Use different levels, and perhaps props, to showcase your goods. Avoid laying everything out flat on the table, or all in tubs. **NO deep discounts, bargain basement stock with sell-out pricing, or casual handwritten signs. These will NOT be permitted!** True show specials are encouraged and we will help you promote those.
9. **Demos:** We encourage In-booth Demos—and will help you to market them.
10. **Volunteers:** Volunteers will be greeting customers at the entrance, staffing the registration desk at the door (payment & email address collection), and assisting in other ways. Note that if you use a volunteer to mind your booth for a washroom break, that person will not be responsible for any losses.
11. **Security:** Neither the venue nor the Show Organizers are responsible for the property of customers or vendors, including lost or stolen items. Vendors are reminded to secure their merchandise while in transit, during set-up and on the show floor. The room will be locked overnight.
12. **Marketing:** Vendors are expected to promote the Bead Show through their blog, newsletter, social media, networking, and distribution of Bead Show Cards.
13. **Please note** that absolutely nothing shall be mounted on, hung from, or attached to the walls and/or floors.
